1 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

Dr Cowie welcomed all to the meeting. He advised that Item 6.1 2020 Vision for Clinical Strategy would be removed from the agenda as the Chief Executive was unable to attend the meeting to speak to this report.

2 APOLOGIES

Apologies were noted as above.

3 MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

3.1 MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING - 30 April 2015

The Minute of the Meeting of the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee held on 30 April 2015 was accepted as an accurate record subject to the following amendments:-

Page 3 - Item 5.2 Academic Health Science Network paragraph four should read the following:-

- 1. Education and Lifelong Learning
- 2. Research
- 3. Quality Improvement and Safety

4. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

4.1 Declaration of Interests – Agenda Items and Any Updates to the Register

There were no declarations of interests.

5 STRATEGIC DIRECTION

5.1 Academic Health Science Partnership in Tayside (AHSP)

Professor Belch highlighted the following:-

- She was also speaking on behalf of Professor Dilip Nathwani who was very much involved in the Academic Health Science Partnership
- Liaison between NHS Tayside and the University of Dundee had produced a Mission Statement highlighting an aim to improve health nationally and globally.
- The AHSP would act a forum unique in Scotland to link NHS Tayside and the University of Dundee.
- The aim was to provide an integrated environment to align strategic priorities contributing to population health and enable more effective joint delivery of health related education and learning, service quality improvement and safety.
- The Priorities, Summaries and Deliverables were contained within the report
- Plans were in place to provide reports to each meeting of the USLC.
- The full launch of the AHSP would take place in November 2015 with the Health Minister. This is currently the only AHSP in Scotland and is Grant

- Funded. England has 5 AHSP which are all Government Funded.
- Meetings have been undertaken with Abertay University and St Andrews. A
 meeting has been arranged with Aberdeen University for November 2015 with
 tentative discussions being taken forward with Stirling University, NHS Fife and
 NHS Forth Valley to provide information around the role of the AHSP and
 possible coordination.
- There are 41 Consultants within NHS Tayside and NHS Fife who have sessions funded by the university for research, acting as a valuable enticement toi new applicants.
- Patient wifi has been introduced within Ninewells Hospital.

The Committee discussed the following:-

- Clinical effectiveness, patient safety and workforce issues would need to be kept under review especially in light of external funding being received.
- A focus had to be progressed in relation to priorities and ensure work was not diverted. The University of Dundee and NHS Tayside would remain working together.
- There was a hope that there would not be an introduction of large numbers of AHSPs across Scotland, and that this AHSP would remain unique to this area.
- Discussions were being undertaken with Ms Jennifer Mudie around workforce and 9:1 contracts for consultants, which tend to discourage academic participation.
- Communication had to be correct to ensure staff recognised the AHSP within the various Organisations. Professor Nathwani had discussed this issue with Directors and staff were being updated at regular intervals. A website and newsletter were being published from both the University of Dundee and NHS Tayside.
- Research grants of around £1M had been brought in through the 41 Consultants.
- Surgical skill staff training could possibly be a focus area for Scotland wide service delivery
- An Executive Committee had been established with an Executive Lead for each work stream and 15 members in each team to ensure overall engagement from the bottom up. Work streams were led by those in the workplace and therefore reporting
- An external organisation were currently looking at the AHSP brand which would provide different types of working models and ensure deliverables were achieved.
- Queries were raised as to how Abertay University and St Andrews University would be brought into the working models. Professor Belch highlighted that a critical mass within East and Central Scotland would be a great initiative. The Board has asked that work be cemented in Dundee currently to ensure nothing was diverted to other areas at present. Work would be taken slowly to ensure added value to the Partnership. Further work was being undertaken to engage with other Health Boards. The Scottish Government would expect partnership arrangements and recognise the establishment of the AHSP with many varying organisations. A small working system was the initial step with the forming of relations to be taken forward at a later date.
- Set deliverables would be helpful such as commissioning a review of the Education Strategy. Recruitment for those taking Masters Degrees in Quality Improvement would be increased during 2015/16.
- Collaboration would be undertaken with other Universities around the placements of nurses in training which would ensure working together

- continued. There was an opportunity to shape the nurses undergraduate curriculum for 2016.
- It was agreed that Professor Belch would provide a list of deliverables which would be forwarded to the Committee by Mrs Owen
- In relation to Advanced Nurse Practitioners roles and responsibilities had to be clear. Clear guidance would be available around education, practice and leadership. No funding for this was received from the Government.
- Developments in national requirements cannot be allowed to disrupt the flow of training for nurses.
- Queries were raised in relation to workforce numbers due to the decrease in nursing undergraduate numbers as funding was based on what was perceived to be affordable. Further discussions would take place outwith the meeting.
- There was a keen sense that liaison with St Andrews University, Abertay University and the University of Dundee should be taken forward with the Board wishing to provide help during these discussions.
- Professor Crossman advised that meetings had been arranged to discuss matters with Professor Belch however he would like NHS Fife to be invited as there should be no distinction between the Boards.
- Partnership working would be welcomed and would have to be defined
- Work was being undertaken with the Scottish Government to ensure NHS
 Tayside was not seen as a small Board. Currently there were excellent
 relations with NHS Fife and a Partnership would be taken forward in a timely
 fashion.

The Universities Strategic Liaison Committee:-

- Noted the update by Professor Belch.
- Agreed an update would be provided to each meeting.
- Minutes of the AHSP Executive would be circulated to members of the Committee in a timely fashion.

Universities Strategic Liaison Committee

1.1 Purpose

The Committee will advise the Board on strategic matters concerning clinical teaching, research, ACT funding and facility requirements.

The Committee will provide an inclusive forum for strategic dialogue, development and planning between the Universities of Dundee, Abertay and St Andrews and with the NHS in Tayside and Fife.

1.2 Composition

Membership of the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee will be:

A minimum of four Non-Executive Members of Tayside NHS Board including:

- University of Dundee Stakeholder Member
- Employee Director
- Area Clinical Forum Chair
- Chief Executive, NHS Tayside (Lead Officer)
- representatives from the University of Dundee covering Medicine, Nursing and Dentistry
- 2 representatives from St Andrews University covering Medicine and Nursing
- 2 representatives from Abertay University covering Medicine and Nursing
- 2 representatives from Fife NHS Board
- 1 representative NHS Education for Scotland
- 4 Representatives from AHSP

The Chair will be a Non Executive Member of Tayside NHS Board. The Vice-Chair will be a representative of one of the Universities.

Other Directors will only attend if they are presenting a report to the Committee or the Committee requests their attendance.

1.3 Meetings

Meetings of the Committee shall be quorate when five or more Members are present, at least two of whom will be a Non-Executive Member of the Board.

1.4 Remit

To provide the opportunity for collaborative dialogue in relation to government policies and their impact within the region

To provide a dialogue around the new 20/20 Workforce Vision

To provide the opportunity for collaborative development and planning in relation to research and development in Healthcare

To engage and inform future strategies for community health and social care and research

Consider teaching and training resources for the next 5 years

To provide strategic guidance in developing models of healthcare

1.5 Authority

The Committee is authorised by the Board to investigate any activity within its terms of reference, and is authorised to seek any information it requires from any employee.

In order to fulfil its remit, the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee may obtain whatever professional advice it requires, and require Directors or other officers to attend meetings.

1.6 Reporting Arrangements

The Universities Strategic Liaison Committee reports to Tayside NHS Board.

Following a meeting of the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee, the minutes of that meeting should be presented at the next Tayside NHS Board meeting.

The Universities Strategic Liaison Committee should annually and within three months of the start of the financial year provide a work plan detailing the work to be taken forward by the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee.

The Universities Strategic Liaison Committee will produce an Annual Report for presentation to the Audit Committee. The Annual Report will describe the outcomes from the Committee during the year and provide an assurance to the Audit Committee that the Committee has met its

remit during the year. The Annual Report must be approved by the Universities Strategic Liaison Committee before it is presented to the Audit Committee meeting considering the Annual Accounts.
